AGRONOMY NOTES

MZ 4623SMX is a hybrid with medium plant and ear height. It flowers late for its maturity but grain dries quickly. Husk cover is long and opens well at harvest. Agronomics are solid. Ears are large (18 rows) with deep heavy kernels. Position north and south of maturity zone. Optimal yield at moderate populations (33-36K).

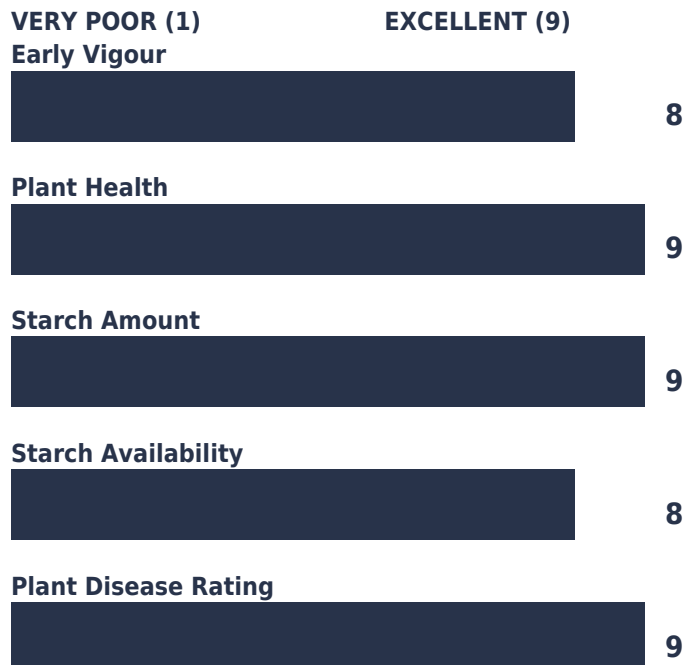

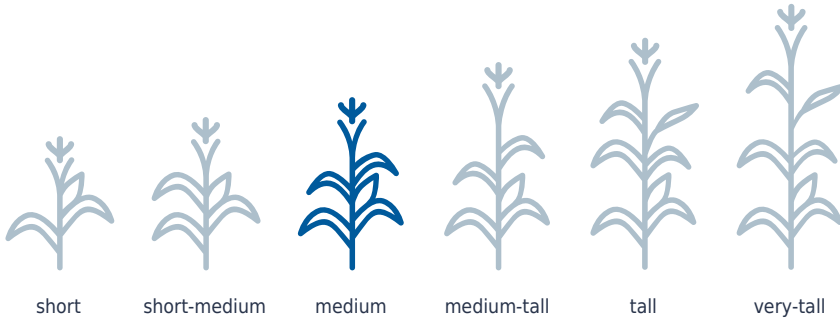
